Subject: CPUC Reportable Gas Incident

On January 7, 2014, at approximately 0821 hours, the Hayward Fire Department reported a gas odor inside [Redacted] located at [Redacted] in Hayward. The Fire Department shut off the gas and the California Highway Patrol evacuated approximately 700 people from the building. A Pacific Gas and Electric (PG&E) gas service representative was onsite at 0840 hours. At approximately 0845 hours, when the gas odor dissipated, the evacuated people were let back into the building. A PG&E leak survey crew is en route to conduct a leak survey to investigate the cause and the source of the gas odor. Channel 7 News was on the scene at approximately 0840 hours, making this incident reportable to the CPUC.
