All:

On January 16, 2014 am a fire ignited, suspected due to arson near the city of Glendora (Los Angeles County). Utility facilities are not connected to the ignition of the fire. The fire is now being called the Colby Fire, and has destroyed 2 residences, shut down several schools and burned over 1,700 acres. The fire is currently not contained at all.

The fire has caused damage to SCE utility poles and the related equipment, the exact amount of damage is unknown at this time. One SCE distribution circuit relayed (shut off due to smoke) resulting in a power outage to 79 customers. SCE is still in the process of accessing the damage to its facilities in the area.

Currently, no gas facilities have been affected by the fire.
