I know there will be places for more formal RA compliance filings later in the year and/or we could follow up this email with some formal data requests, but as a starting point it would be helpful if I could get an informal analysis of what impacts PG&E thinks a drought in 2014 would have on system reliability, prices, and GHG emissions.
