The Joint Utilities (PG&E, SCE, SoCalGas, SDG&E, SMUD, LADWP, EBMUD) and the CIPs (AT&T, Comcast, Sunesys, CCTA, Time Warner Cable, TW Telecom, T-Mobile) propose that Section III of the Technical Panel Report be revised as follows:

## III. REVISED GENERAL ORDER

The attached revised General Order contains the elements and regulations that CHSRA believes are needed to run a safe and reliable 25 kV electrification system for High Speed Train in California. During the course of the panel meetings, the parties proposed suggested edits to the General Order and CHSRA and the parties addressed the comments to inform CHSRA of concerns. Below is a list of some of the topics that require further discussion and study, including, but not limited to:

- Casings of Gas Pipelines
- Definition of Agency
- Lower Voltage Lines Over CHSRA Lines
- Training Rules
- Overhead and Underground Crossings
- Grounding and Touch Potentials
- Dispute Resolution Process
