Nathan Doble (Transportation Research Analyst) from the NTSB called me earlier this week to discuss a safety study the NTSB is conducting related to Transmission Integrity Management. Here are my notes from the meeting.

- The NTSB conducts safety studies on topics at a high level, the results of which are generally safety recommendations targeted at federal and state regulators and standards bodies
- The NTSB is currently undertaking a study of Transmission Integrity Management
- He is hoping to make a visit to PG&E in the next month or so, along with representation from the CPUC, to ask questions about how we are implementing TIMP
- The areas of focus will include:
  - HCA Identification
  - Threat Identification
  - Risk Assessment

- o GIS Capabilities and Support
