Attached is a suspension notice for AL 3442-G. I will be drafting a Resolution for this Advice Letter. We have some questions below that need your assistance.

- [Redacted] PG&E acquired a 15-foot wide easement by deed (original easement) dated June 1, 1944, from [Redacted]
- When did Samsung take over the property from the [Redacted] family and their easement right?
- Why did PG&E need to redefine the original easement (to allow space for construction)?
- [Redacted] Please provide a diagram to highlight the areas of the original and modified easements, and the area that PG&E proposes to quitclaim to Samsung.
- [Redacted] What is the cost of this 500 feet pipeline relocation?
- [Redacted] How long does it take to relocate the pipeline?
- [Redacted] Did PG&E obtained/modified its franchise agreement with the City of San Jose for the public right-of-way? If so, when?
