**Subject:** CPUC Reportable Incident - San Francisco

At approximately 2:32pm, PG&E was notified of a 3<sup>rd</sup> party dig-in at the intersection of 25<sup>th</sup> St & Diamond St in San Francisco that caused an unintentional release of gas. The line struck was a 4" plastic main. PG&E GSR / Crews were on site at 2:50pm. Traffic has been blocked, and a nearby school, James Lake Middle School, has been evacuated. The FD / PD / Media were all on site. There were no fires / explosions / injuries / fatalities in result of this incident. There are 4 service interruptions as a result of this incident. The flow of gas was stopped at 3:10pm. Repairs are estimated to be complete at approximately 7:00pm. The 3<sup>rd</sup> party involved was [Redacted] According to the supervisor on site, [Redacted] it is unclear whether the 3<sup>rd</sup> party was working under a valid USA ticket, and it is unclear whether there were proper markings for the gas lines.

This incident is reportable to the CPUC due to the presence of media.
