The line struck was a 4" plastic main. PG&E GSR / Crews were on site at 2:50pm. Traffic has been blocked, and a nearby school, James Lake Middle School, has been evacuated. The FD / PD / Media were all on site. There were no fires / explosions / injuries / fatalities in result of this incident. There are 4 service interruptions as a result of this incident. The flow of gas was stopped at 3:10pm. Repairs are estimated to be complete at approximately 7:00pm. The 3<sup>rd</sup> party involved was According to the supervisor on site, Redacted unclear whether the 3<sup>rd</sup> party was working under a valid USA ticket, and it is unclear whether there were proper markings for the gas lines.
