Subject: CPUC Reportable Incident - San Jose

At approximately 10:52am, PG&E was notified of a third party dig in at Redacted in San Jose that caused an unintentional release of gas. The line struck was a ½ inch plastic service coming off of a 10" steel main. PG&E GSR was on site at 11:06am. PG&E Crews were on site at 12:19pm. The fire department / police department evacuated a nearby bank, and blocked off the traffic to the area to restrict access around the incident. Media came on site at an unknown time. There were no fires / explosions / injuries / fatalities as a result to this incident. The flow of gas was stopped at 2:01pm. There have been 94 service interruptions as a result to this incident. Service is expected to be restored by 5:00pm. The 3<sup>rd</sup> party is Northern Underground Construction. A contact for the 3<sup>rd</sup> party is Dan Herrera Redacted . The 3<sup>rd</sup> party was working under a valid USA ticket, and the area was marked. According to the supervisor on site, the markings for the 10" steel main were accurate, however, the markings for the ½" plastic service appeared to be inaccurate.

This incident is reportable to the CPUC due to the presence of media.
