This job was called in at 21:29pm. GSR arrived at 21:43. GSR [Redacted] responded to this. Upon GSR's arrival, he found the shut off valve to the furnace was shut off by the owner and the fire department had shut the gas off at the meter. GSR notified on-call supervisor of this incident. GSR clock tested the houseline and the houseline held. He then turned the service back on. Since the furnace was damaged by the explosion, he could not tell the true cause of the explosion. A good guess from the GSR would be a delay ignition. There was no injuries, no fire and no media.
