At approximately 11:30 this morning PG&E received a call regarding a potential explosive device placed at or near a four meter manifold that 742 Valencia St., San Francisco. Police have established a command post and the bomb squad is on site. Nearby buildings have been evacuated and Valencia is blocked off at 18th and 19th Streets. Gas service representative arrived on site at 11:58 hours and PG&E is establishing incident command. At this writing there are no injuries, no fatalities and no damages. This is reportable to the CPUC due to the presence of major media on site and the potential involvement of gas facilities.
