PG&E Officer Team;

The purpose of this communication is to make you aware that at 9 p.m. today, we will begin to safely ramp Unit 2 to 25 percent power in anticipation of a highenergy swell event. The decision to ramp Unit 2 is squarely in line with the Institute of Nuclear Power Operations' "Traits of a Health Nuclear Safety Culture" and our team's commitment to conservative decision-making.

Our team will continue to safely operate Unit 2 at 25 percent power until observations and real-time weather data show the swell event has passed, which is forecast to occur tomorrow. Unit 1 remains in Mode 6 for refueling.

We will update you after we safely return Unit 2 to 100 percent power. If you have any questions or concerns, please reach out to me at your convenience. Thank you.
