Entire bill text:

958.2. The commission shall adopt rules for gas corporations to follow when determining the maximum allowable operating pressure for an intrastate transmission line installed prior to July 1, 1970. The rules adopted by the commission shall be compatible with the requirements of Section 192.619(a) and Section 192.620 of Subpart L of Part 192 of Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations, or any successor regulations adopted by the federal Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration.
