After a warm, but near normal precipitation in February, you'll be pleased to know that our Mar 1 YTD precipitation is back up to a 48% of normal (from a low of 20%). Snowpack has grown to 32% of normal.

While still not great news, this represents a significant improvement from where we were, and we're now back in a water supply situation we have dealt with before.

We have about 30% of our precip season to go. Wish for snow and low winds, and a mellow, and slightly cool spring for a calm melt and runoff.
