In accordance with the provisions of Rule 1.4 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the California Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”), EDF Renewable Energy, Inc. respectfully moves for party status in this proceeding.

I. EDF RENEWABLE ENERGY’S INTEREST IN THIS PROCEEDING

Headquartered in San Diego and directly employing over 300 employees in California in four offices through the state, EDF Renewable Energy is a developer, owner and operator of wind, solar, biomass, and biogas resources. In the U.S., EDF Renewable Energy has developed over 3,600 MW of wind projects, over 230 MW of solar photovoltaic projects, and 100 MW of biomass/biogas projects, including numerous wind and solar projects throughout California. More specifically to this proceeding, EDF Renewable Energy is developing a pumped hydro storage project in southern Oregon that can directly benefit California ratepayers.

EDF Renewable Energy seeks party status primarily so as to be able to file comments on the February 11, 2014 Proposed Decision (“PD”) of ALJ Gamson entitled *Decision Authorizing Long-term Procurement for Local Capacity Requirements Due to Permanent Retirement of the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Stations*. EDF Renewable Energy also contemplates

participating in this and future phases of the proceeding as issues related to pumped hydro storage and renewable resource development in general may arise.

EDF Renewable Energy's interests are not represented by any other party to this proceeding, and its comments on the PD will be directly relevant to the issues addressed therein. Granting EDF Renewable Energy party status will not prejudice any other party, will not delay the procedural schedule, and will not broaden the scope of the issues in the proceeding.
