Allocation of Time by Issue

In the foregoing time sheets, the ratepayer advocates worked on a number of specific issues as well as on general issues, identified below with a number code.

The identification of each issue within the scope of the proceeding is discussed for each issues in section II.B, above and in the attached advocate time records. Women's Energy Matters estimates approximately the following allocation of total resource time (attorney and witness) by issue in this proceeding:

Issues Areas (with letter code) % of time

A. Issue 6 from Scoping Memo: How resources aside from conventional generation, such as uncommitted energy efficiency, demand response, energy storage and distributed generation resources should be considered in determining future local reliability needs.	65%
B. Issue 11 from Scoping Memo: What rules should govern procurement of additional local reliability needs not already covered by the Commission's RA rules.	30%
C. Issue 1 from Scoping Memo: Whether additional capacity is required to meet local reliability needs in the Los Angeles Basin and Big Creek/Ventura area between 2014 and 2021, and, if so, how much.	5%
