OP14 requires Commission staff to score the investor-owned utilities (IOUs) on their annual ex ante review performance by January 31 of the year following program implementation. The final 2013 ex ante review performance scores are delayed beyond the January 31 deadline due to the time and effort required to conduct a claims review. Commission staff is currently working with the IOUs to fill in data gaps, clarify data inconsistencies, and process data into a reviewable format. Given the time required to complete these tasks, the final 2013 ex ante review scores are expected by March 31, 2014. This delay is not expected to impact the IOUs' advice letter filing for 2013 preliminary incentive awards due on June 30, 2014.
