At 8:28 AM this morning, PG&E notified the CPUC of a reportable incident due to a leak caused during work on Transmission Line 101 at 640 Whipple Avenue in Redwood City. There

are no injuries and no ignition. The media arrived on the site at approximately 2:30 AM on 3/14/14, making it reportable to the CPUC. To make repairs, L-101 is being taken out of service from Mile points 19.43 to 21.54 this morning.
