Q. Have any Solar City projects in PG&E's service territory been delayed for interconnection for 8 months?

A. No. On two projects, Solar City did decide to wait 6 months to interconnect until PG&E's SmartMeter pilot program was operational to achieve savings on their metering costs.

Q. Have any residential projects triggered supplemental review?

A. No, they have not. All of PG&E's residential SGIP applications that are paired with storage passed initial review.

Good to see you at the tour in San Ramon the other day.

Commissioner Peterman is interested in meeting with some folks from PG&E to discuss the issues with interconnecting customer-side storage systems. From what we understand, PG&E has received hundreds of applications but has only interconnected a handful of projects in the Self-Generation Incentive Program. Commissioner Peterman is interested in better understanding the cause for the delays.
