PG&E received your March 12, 2014, requests for information regarding its leak management processes and repair/replacement of service lines and risers. We have started compiling the requested information and will provide the data responses pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 583. We expect to be able to provide responses by March 28, 2014, to the following Data Requests: 1, 2, 7, 12, 14-15, 17-18, 21-22, 31, 33-34, and 36-38.

We will need additional time to respond to the other 35 data requests due to the level of detail and work that will be required to develop responses. We expect to be able to respond by April 30, 2014, to the following Data Requests: 3-6, 8-11, 13, 16, 19-20, 23-30, 32, 35, and 39-51.

PG&E looks forward to reviewing the best practice results accumulated from this effort.
