All,

As you may be aware there is a large fire in San Francisco near 4th and China Basin. Here is a brief update:

- T-man and Cableman are on site and reviewing our equipment
- Restoration Supervisor is enroute to the scene
- This area is fed by A 1104. This is the only circuit in the area
- IF required, only one switch would need to be operated to de-energize the area. We stand ready upon request.

- Gas Dept has a shutdown plan ready
- Two mainline valves will isolate the gas distribution system if needed. Approximately 25 customers would be impacted if this shutdown is executed.
- Gas Crew is standing by. M&C and CSF Supervisors have checked in with SFFD Incident Command.

The OEC will remain open for communication only until the event is cleared.

Preliminary Information

Risk: High

Concerns: Large media attention, public perception, fire uncontrolled and not contained, employee access into area, possible area shut down of utility service

We have a large commercial building fire in San Francisco at China Basin along 4th Street. We have no PG&E facilities involved at this time and no outages. All our facilities in this area are underground. We have PG&E Gas and Electric first responders onsite and leadership responding. The SF OEC is open for communication to support a joint Gas and Electric response and public safety plan if the fire increases in size or if requested to shut down our facilities.

As information becomes available updates will follow from [Redacted] as the IC, [Redacted] is Deputy IC.
