The conversation focused on the Commission's staff proposal revising the renewable net short

calculation and the Commission's staff proposal to reform procurement review processes for the RPS

program. In both matters, UCS stressed the importance of flexibility in the RPS program, the ability of

utilities to voluntarily procure renewables and how the staff proposals could prevent voluntary

procurement.
