Pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Practice and Procedure 16.4(g), PG&E requests leave to file a reply to the response of the Large-Scale Solar Association ("LSA") and the Solar Electric Industry Association ("SEIA") to PG&E's Petition for Expedited Order Granting Modification of D.10-12-048 (the "RAM Petition").

Under the default timeline established by Rule 16.4(g), PG&E's reply would be due next Monday, April 7 (ten days after the March 28 deadline for filing responses to the Petition). Given the short time remaining before that date, PG&E requests leave to file a reply within four days of any approval of this request.

LSA/SEIA served a joint response to the RAM Petition on March 28, 2014.
