Dear Supplier,

For more than three (3) decades, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) has been committed to creating a robust Supplier Diversity Program. In 2012, we reached a tremendous milestone by spending over \$2.0 billion with Diverse Business Enterprises (DBEs), representing 38.8 percent (38.8%) of PG&E's total procurement spend. Our prime suppliers reported a collective \$610 million in subcontracting with DBEs last year and we expect you to continue to grow your supplier diversity programs alongside PG&E.

As you prepare and finalize your 2013 reports to PG&E on supplier diversity subcontracting, I want to remind you that accuracy of reported DBE subcontracting dollars is critical. I also urge you, whenever possible, to make subcontractor payments in the year the work was completed and report those payments within the calendar year that PG&E pays you for the related goods and services. In preparing your reports, please make sure to adhere to the following guidelines:

- Reported subcontracting dollars must be directly related to PG&E work.
- Reported subcontracting dollars must reflect payments made to suppliers, net of any voided transactions, estimates, early payment discounts, markups, etc.
- Records to document your subcontracting dollars must be kept for a period of three (3) years.

  These records should clearly document that the work performed was for PG&E and that payment was made to the subcontractor.

PG&E's Prime Supplier Program (PSP) establishes and maintains a subcontracting program for purchases/contracts exceeding \$500,000. PG&E's Prime Supplier Guide is designed to provide you with tools to develop a successful supplier diversity program and accurately report your subcontracting successes to PG&E.
