CHAPTER 5

I. INTRODUCTION

My testimony describes San Diego Gas & Electric Company's (SDG&E) cost recovery mechanism for the Vehicle-Grid Integration (VGI) Pilot Program proposed in this Application.

SDG&E requests authority to establish a new Vehicle Grid Integration Balancing

Account (VGIBA) to track and account for revenues and costs associated with SDG&E's VGI

Pilot Program, as described in the testimony of SDG&E witness Randy Schimka (Chapter 2).

This two-way interest bearing VGIBA is needed to record revenue and incremental costs (i.e., incremental to existing company resources) resulting from implementing the VGI Pilot Program. SDG&E proposes that the balancing account records the authorized revenue requirement and actual operations and maintenance (O&M) and capital-related costs (e.g., depreciation expense, authorized return on equity, and taxes) incurred for the VGI Pilot Program. The details of the revenue requirement are presented in the testimony of SDG&E witness Jonathan Atun (Chapter 4).

The disposition of this account will be addressed in SDG&E's Annual Regulatory

Account Balance Update filing, or other applicable proceeding as directed by the Commission.

However, during the installation period (2015-2019), any over/under-collection will be carried forward to the following year until the end of the period currently projected to be on or about 2019.

This concludes my direct testimony.

II. QUALIFICATIONS
