Ms. Reid and Mr. Gerber described how much DR MW might be feasible to bid into the CAISO markets in 2014. Mr. Ho and Mr. DeBacker explained how there were several limits to what could be bid in as PDR. Mr. Ho explained that there was potential for additional, but limited, DR in 2015 and beyond and that any major MW commitment to PDR would require a significant IT investment. Mr. Ho further explained that request for this investment will be made after the DR OIR and in PG&E's next DR budget request now planned for the end for November 2015. Rule 8.4(c)]
