WHAT April 16 marks the one-year anniversary of the attack on Pacific Gas and Electric Company's (PG&E) [Redacted] [Redacted] near San Jose. The company will announce a reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of an individual(s) in connection with the incident. PG&E has been working aggressively to protect critical electric grid infrastructure and is investing approximately \$100 million over the next three years on substation security at its highest priority facilities.

Representatives from the Edison Electric Institute (EEI), the association that represents the U.S. utility industry, will also be on hand to explain the extensive measures the industry is taking to work with policy makers and enhance security.
