Subject: R1309011: Email Ruling Denying Request to Extend Deadline for Testimony

On April 10, 2014, the Sierra Club, The Utility Reform Network (TURN), Natural Resources Defense Council, Environmental Defense Fund, and Clean Coalition jointly filed a motion requesting that:

- the time to serve prepared testimony be extended by three weeks, from May 6 to May 27, 2014 for opening testimony, and from May 20 to June 10, 2014 for rebuttal testimony;
- one or more workshops be scheduled to encourage collaborative discussions on Demand Response Auction Mechanism before parties serve testimony on that topic; and
- the remainder of the proposed schedule for evidentiary hearings, if needed, and for opening and reply briefs be extended accordingly.

The following parties sent emails of support: California Energy Efficiency Industry Council, California Large Energy Consumers Alliance, Center for Energy Efficiency and Renewable Technologies, Direct Access Customer Coalition/ Alliance for Retail Energy Markets, EnerNOC, Inc., Comverge, Inc., and Johnson Controls, Inc.(Joint Demand Response Parties), Marin Clean Energy, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E), and Southern California Edison Company (SCE). Furthermore, PG&E and SCE requested that the deadline for testimony to be served be extended for six weeks. The joint Demand Response Parties sent an additional email of support for the six week extension.

The request to extend the deadline for serving testimony is denied. Such an extension would delay a decision until 2015.

However, parties will be provided the following two opportunities to learn more and ask questions about the Demand Response Auction Mechanism or DRAM.

1. On April 28, 2014, the Energy Division will hold a Q&A session on DRAM. Additional details regarding the session will be provided shortly.
2. On May 22, 2014, the Energy Division will facilitate an additional meeting to discuss the details of DRAM. Again, additional details on the meeting will be provided shortly.

In addition, I encourage parties to meet on their own to have “collaborative discussions” on the DRAM prior to serving testimony.

The Docket Office shall formally file this ruling.
