<u>Subject:</u> Withdrawal of Advice Letter 4339-E, Schedules NEM, NEMV, NEMVMASH and NEMFC Changes in Compliance With Assembly Bill 327

In accordance with General Order 96-B, Section 5.3, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby withdraws the above-referenced advice letter without prejudice.

On December 31, 2013, PG&E submitted Advice 4339-E to revise its Net Energy Metering (NEM) tariffs to comply with Assembly Bill (AB) 327 and Decision (D.) 13-11-026 vacating D.12-05-036, *Decision Regarding Calculation of the Net Energy Metering Cap.* This advice letter is still pending Energy Division approval; however, Energy Division has requested for PG&E to withdraw Advice 4339-E due to the issuance of D.14-03-041, *Decision Establishing a Transition Period Pursuant to Assembly Bill 327 for Customers Enrolled in Net Energy Metering Tariffs*, which further revises the net energy metering cap language in the tariffs submitted in Advice 4339-E. Therefore, PG&E respectfully withdraws Advice 4339-E.

In accordance with General Order 96-B, Section 5.3, this withdrawal letter is being submitted in the same manner and served on the same persons as the advice letters.
