**RE: WITHDRAWAL OF SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC AL 2588-E; MODIFICATIONS TO THE STANDARD CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF ELIGIBLE RENEWABLE GENERATION FROM THE RENEWABLE MARKET ADJUSTING PROGRAM**

Dear Mr. Randolph

In accordance with GO 96.B, Section 5.3, San Diego Gas & Electric (“SDG&E”) hereby withdraws Advice Letter (AL) 2588-E filed on March 25, 2014. The purpose of AL 2588-E was to incorporate changes consistent with Decision (“D.”) 13-11-024, which conditionally accepted the 2013 Renewables Portfolio Standard (“RPS”) plans for the three Investor Owned Utilities (“IOU”) which implements SDG&E’s Renewable Market Adjusting Tariff (“ReMAT”).

SDG&E is withdrawing AL 2588-E pursuant to Energy Division’s guidance that D.13-11-024 does not grant SDG&E the authority to update Time of Delivery Factors in the Standard Form ReMAT Power Purchase Agreement. SDG&E intends to re-file its Advice Letter to reflect only the updated standard term and condition (“STC”) for Green Attributes, consistent with D.13-11-024.

In accordance with General Order 96-B, Section 5.3, this withdrawal letter is being submitted in the same manner and served on the same persons as AL 2588-E.
