Customer Communications Update

A truck hit a pole at the Port of Oakland bring down a 2nd pole and wrapping the conductor around itself. There is a loose span of conductor hanging over the BART tracks running to and from the SF tube. We will be asking BART to shut down power to these tracks while we remove the loose conductor.

PG&E and BART have been in close communications throughout. Final repairs will be made after BART train operations end for the day.

This outage also impacted the Port of Oakland and a number of Port tenants. Several crane operations were impacted, however, most of the Port, which is feed from transmission, was not impacted. No major impacts have been reported at this time other than lost operations.

Currently East Bay is experiencing a sustained outage caused by a truck hitting a pole at 7th and Maritime near the Port of Oakland:

- M&C Supervisor and crew onsite
- Estimators onsite
- Two broken poles
- Three phases, three spans 715A down

- Two phases one span dangling approximately 12' over the BART tracks
- Currently 11 customers are out of power, crew will look to pick up additional customers once the wire is removed from over the BART tracks
- Media Relations has been notified
