Subject: R.13-09-011 PG&E cross-examination estimates in response to Email Ruling Revising Hearing Schedule

ALJ Hymes,

In response to your e-mail ruling issued Friday, May 30, establishing workshops on June 9 and 10, and setting hearing for June 11 and 12, PG&E provides its current

estimate of time it requests for cross examination in this proceeding. PG&E's current estimates of its cross-examination time are

1) for the CAISO witnesses, approximately 2 hours and 5 minutes (1 hour for Mr. Goodin, 30 minutes for Mr. Millar, 20 minutes for Dr. Kristov, and 15 minutes for Mr. Laundergan);

2) for the Environmental Defense Fund (approximately 30 minutes for Mr. Moss);

3) for Calpine (approximately 15 minutes for Dr. Barmack.)

These are PG&E's best estimates now, but they may change depending on the workshop outcomes and cross-examination by other parties. With respect to DACC/AReM witness Sue Mara, Mr. Douglas indicated in his 10:15 am e-mail on May 30, that "if all other parties are willing to waive cross of DACC/AReM witness Sue Mara, we would similarly be willing to waive cross of all other parties." In response, PG&E states that it agrees to waive cross of Ms. Mara.

PG&E requests that the order for witness appearances be established by the end of this week, so travel arrangements can be made. PG&E also requests a date certain for Dr. Jay Zarnikau.

With respect to the June 9 and 10 workshops, PG&E understand that it will be making a presentation on CAISO integration costs on June 9, in the afternoon. We are unclear, however, about whether PG&E should also have presentations ready for the morning of June 9, and for the topics schedule for June 10. We would appreciate clarification from your Honor on this question.
