Draft Resolution E-4665 July 10, 2014 Commission Meeting

TO: PARTIES TO DRAFT RESOLUTION E-4665

Enclosed is Draft Resolution E-4665 which approves modifications to Southern California Edison Company (SCE), and San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) Net Energy Metering (NEM) Tariffs to enable multiple meter aggregation pursuant to Senate Bill (SB) 594 (Wolk, 2012) and Resolution E-4610. This Resolution approves with modifications SCE Advice Letter 2952-E, SCE Advice Letter 2952-E-A, SDG&E Advice Letter 2529-E, and SDG&E Advice Letter 2529-E-A implementing NEM aggregation, pursuant to SB 594 and Resolution E-4610.

Draft Resolution E-4665 will be on the agenda at the next Commission meeting that is at least 30 days from the date of this letter, which is the July 10, 2014 Commission Meeting. The Commission may then vote on this Draft Resolution or it may postpone a vote until later.

When the Commission votes on a Draft Resolution, it may adopt all or part of it as written, amend, modify or set it aside and prepare a different Resolution. Only when the Commission acts does the Resolution become binding on the parties.

Parties may submit comments on the Draft Resolution within 20 days of this draft, Monday June 23, 2014. Reply comments are due Monday June 30, 2014.
