MOTION OF TERRA-GEN POWER, LLC TO BECOME A PARTY

Pursuant to Rules 1.4 and 11.1 of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure, Terra-Gen Power, LLC (“Terra-Gen”) hereby submits this motion to become a party to this proceeding. Under Rule 1.4(a)(4), a person may become a party to a proceeding by filing a motion requesting party status. Specifically, Terra-Gen requests party status in this proceeding for the purpose of filing a petition for expedited modification of Decision (“D.”) 13-02-015. Terra-Gen may also participate in later stages, if any, of this and related proceedings.

Terra-Gen is one of the largest supplier of renewable power in California. As developers, owners, and operators of renewable energy facilities in California, Terra-Gen and its affiliates are committed to well-structured markets and processes that encourage the development and procurement of high-quality generation resources and promote the best value for ratepayers.
