II. DESCRIPTION OF PARTY

EPUC is an ad hoc group representing the electric end use and customer generation interests of the following companies: Aera Energy LLC, Chevron U.S.A. Inc., ExxonMobil Power and Gas Services Inc., Phillips 66 Company,

Shell Oil Products US, Tesoro Refining & Marketing Company LLC, THUMS Long Beach Company, and Occidental of Elk Hills, Inc.

III. STATEMENT OF INTEREST

EPUC members are large power customers of Pacific Gas & Electric and Southern California Edison and receive firm electric service from the electric supply facilities. Due to the nature and requirements of the EPUC facilities, service disruptions can have property and safety consequences on customer premises. EPUC members have a demonstrated interest in receiving utility service that is safe and reliable. Notably, EPUC has been participating in R.13-11-006, the Commission proceeding to revise the rate case plan to incorporate safety and reliability risk-based decision making.

IV. STATEMENT OF INTENDED CONTENTIONS

EPUC supports the Commission's efforts to adopt additional tools necessary to deter further outages and the related safety impacts. EPUC intends to comment on the proposed electric safety citation plan and will offer refinements or clarifications to the Commission's proposal.

EPUC respectfully requests that the Commission expeditiously grant this motion for party status; EPUC intends to file comments in this proceeding on Friday, June 20, 2014.
