

The imperfect rule of thumb is that the ones on wooden poles in that neighborhood are PG&E, and that the ones on metal poles are City of San Francisco. I've been told that the lion's share in Bayview are PG&E. A lot of cities are asking this question right now about PG&E lights and city-owned lights, and we have been working with all of them. The GRC draft decision even includes a section that deals with the switch to LEDs for PG&E lights.
