

Utility Bulletin: TD-4001B-004
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Definitions: Gas Transmission and Distribution Terms

Summary

This bulletin announces approved definitions for terms used to describe gas transmission and distribution systems. This bulletin announces a revised definition for transmission line that extends the term to cover all distribution feeder mains with maximum allowable operating pressures greater than 60 psig.

This revised definition primarily impacts integrity management, leak survey, and patrolling processes. These definitions are effective January 1, 2015 to allow adequate time for gas operations personnel to prepare for this significant change. The revision is being made to: 1) improve public safety, 2) align the definitions with recent DOT PHMSA guidance, and 3) increase understanding and consistent use of the term, "transmission line," across all gas operations programs.

PG&E personnel need to use these terms appropriately in gas guidance documents, specifications, and messages to facilitate clear communication to ensure proper maintenance and operation of gas transmission and distribution (t&d) systems.

Target Audience

Gas operations personnel who: implement integrity management programs, design, construct, maintain or operate gas transmission or distribution systems, develop or update gas guidance documents, conduct maximum allowable operating pressure (MAOP) validations, or maintain records or maps.
