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EX PARTE NOTICE OF THE UTILITY REFORM NETWORK

Pursuant to Rules 8.2, 8.3, and 8.4 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, The Utility Reform Network (TURN) gives notice of the following ex parte communication in this proceeding.

On August 8, 2014, Marcel Hawiger, Staff Attorney at TURN, met with Christine Hammond, Advisor, and Kenneth Koss, Chief of Staff, to Commissioner Michael Picker, at 4:00 p.m. The meeting was in-person, lasted approximately 15 minutes, and took place on the 5th Floor of the Commission's office building located at 505 Van Ness Avenue, San Francisco, California, 94102. Mr. Hawiger initiated the meeting.

Mr. Hawiger discussed the Proposed Decision of Administrative Law Judge Thomas R. Pulsifer (GRC PD), issued in PG&E's 2014 General Rate Case, Phase 1 (A.12-11-009), on June 18, 2014. Mr. Hawiger noted that the combination of increases authorized in the GRC PD and increases requested in PG&E's Gas Transmission and Storage rate case, A.13-12-012, would result in bill increases of 30% for residential customers in 2015.

Mr. Hawiger used no written materials in the meeting.
