• Operating pressure at time of discovery on 8/26/14 was 280 psig (21.54% SMYS) which was then reduced by 20% to 224 psig (17.23%) on 8/27 and then further reduced to 5 psig later in the same day.

• 9/2 – 9/6: estimated dates for emergency excavation and pipe examination.
