Subject: Reportable Gas Incident - Earthquake in Napa County

At approximately 0320 hours on August 24, 2014, a magnitude 6.0 earthquake struck the Napa County area. PG&E has received and responded to customer odor calls and calls from Fire and Police agencies throughout the morning. PG&E has confirmed and remediated damages to a number of service risers at addresses throughout the Napa area (approximately 5 instances as of the time of this notification). No major outages in natural gas delivery have been confirmed. No injuries or fatalities resulting from issues with PG&E gas facilities have been confirmed. PG&E is reporting this to the DOT and the CPUC based on operator judgment of the significance of this event.
