At approx. 1747 hrs PG&E was notified that an AC transit bus collided into a home(duplex) at 789 18<sup>th</sup> St. &1770 Garvin Ave. in Richmond. The Police were chasing a stolen car that collided into the bus, causing the bus to crash into the home, taking out two gas meters and risers, causing an unintentional release of gas. Approx. 12 people were injured and sent to the hospital due to the crash and not the release of gas. The FD shut of the flow of gas before the GSR arrived onsite. GSR arrived onsite at approx. 1810 hrs, confirming the area was made safe. The repair crew is cutting the service off at the sidewalk until the home is made habitable.

Channel 4 KRON is onsite and damage will be over \$50k. This incident is being reported to both DOT and CPUC.
