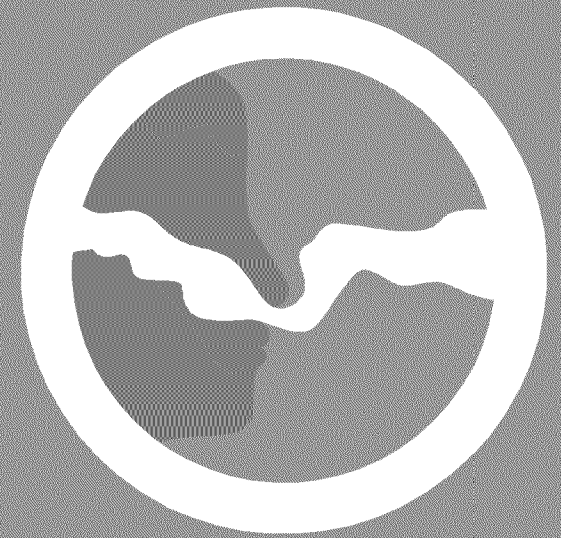


What to do if you smell gas

Natural gas is colorless and odorless. So as a safety precaution, PG&E adds a sulfur-like odor to natural gas to help people identify gas leaks.

If you smell gas, open windows and doors and get everyone out of the building. Using a phone away from the building, call **911** first and then call PG&E at **1-800-743-5000**.
