
The California Public Utilities Commission



Presents Art on the Walls

The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) is looking for art to display in its San Francisco headquarters on an ongoing basis. Shows are 2-6 months in length and will be advertised on the California Public Utilities website at www.cpuc.ca.gov.

Art work will be selected based on merit and theme, and will be available for sale

through the artist. The CPUC neither takes commission on works sold, nor accepts payment on an artist's behalf.

Exhibition space consists of multiple gallery areas on 5 floors within the CPUC headquarters located at 505 Van Ness Avenue in downtown San Francisco. Gallery areas are between two and five spaces approximately 6'x12' in size, and all work will be hung vertically from picture rods on the upper part of walls. Work will be judged on an ongoing basis as submissions are received. Shows are 2-6 months in length depending on the availability of the artwork and the needs of the CPUC.

Artwork Hardware

All art work must be ready to show (hooks and wire on back, and framed if on paper), and labeled. Labels should include price (if for sale) artist's name, title of the piece, and any other information the artist wishes to include.

Submission Requirements

To submit work to Art on the Walls please send:

- 1. 3-10 examples of your work in the form of slides, photos or .jpgs (please don't send originals) with size, title, and media information for each piece. Please also indicate number of pieces available so we can assign you a gallery with the correct amount of wall space.
- 2. Artist's biography
- 3. Artist's statement (optional)
- 4. Stamped self-addressed envelope if you'd like examples of your art work returned to you.
