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# REPORT OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ON COORDINATION OF PLANNED PARTICIPATION

In response to the Assigned Commissioner's Ruling ("ACR") of July 5, 2006, the City of San Diego (the "City") files this report on its efforts thus far to coordinate its participation in this case with that of other parties likely to advocate the same or similar positions.

On August 31, 2006, the City, though the undersigned counsel, participated in a conference call with numerous other parties that have expressed opposition to, or reservations regarding, San Diego Gas & Electric's ("SDG&E's") proposed Sunrise Powerlink transmission line and/or various aspects of the proposed project. The call was coordinated by the Division of Ratepayer Advocates ("DRA") and included participation by many parties, including but not limited to NRG Energy, the cities of Hemet, Temecula, and Murietta, the DRA, UCAN, LS Power, Rancho Penasquitos Concerned Citizens, and the Sierra Club.

The consensus among the participating parties was that it would not be possible to reliably predict the substance of each party's likely position, as it will evolve, given that SDG&E's new filing was only recently made. More time is needed to review the filing and conduct discovery. However, all involved agree that coordination of participation and avoidance of duplication should be pursued, and to this end it was agreed that another similar call should be conducted within the next few weeks, at which time the filing will have been more thoroughly reviewed and some discovery responses received. Thus, the parties

agreed to meet and confer again in several weeks. The City will continue to be an active participant in these discussions.
