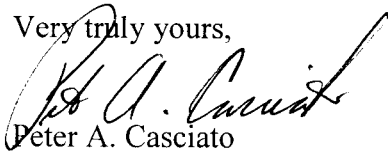

Reverse 911

- Comcast Digital Voice networks are set up to handle “Reverse 911” outside of the 911/E911 design. The PSAP generates the call into the customer. The call appears like a normal inbound call
- Reverse 911 is a process/system managed by the local emergency services jurisdiction. Comcast has an obligation to update the respective ALL database with Customers name, telephone number and MSAG address. Comcast is in full compliance with this obligation.
