Pursuant to the May 28, 2015 Assigned Commissioner’s Ruling (“ACR”), EnerCal USA, LLC (“EUSA”) hereby submits this 2015 Renewables Portfolio Standard (“RPS”) Procurement Plan. In accordance with the Assigned Commissioner’s Ruling, EUSA provides the following responses to paragraphs 6.1 through 6.4, 6.6, 6.13, and 6.15 of the ACR as required of Electric Service Providers.

6.1. Assessment of RPS Portfolio Supplies and Demand - § 399.13(a)(5)(A)

EUSA is a registered Electric Service Provider that is not currently serving retail load and is awaiting a more robust competitive market prior to customer acquisition. EUSA affiliates operate in other competitive market areas with renewable compliance standards through third-party short and long term contractual arrangements. EUSA will comply with the CA RPS program once acquisition activities begin and will focus more on short term forecasting and utilization of the new portfolio content categories to meet compliance.

6.2. Project Development Status Update - § 399.13(a)(5)(D)

EUSA does not currently have RPS compliance obligations and is not currently considering contracts.

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6.3. Potential Compliance Delays - § 399.13(a)(5)(B)

EUSA intends to comply with its RPS requirements and does not anticipate compliance delays.

6.4. Risk Assessment - § 399.13(a)(5)(F)

EUSA does not currently have RPS compliance obligations and is not currently considering contracts.

6.5. Quantitative Information - §§ 399.13(a)(5)(A), (B), (D) and (F)

EUSA does not currently have RPS compliance obligations and has no corresponding quantitative information.

6.6. “Minimum Margin” of Procurement - §§ 399.13(a)(4)(D)

EUSA does not currently have RPS compliance obligations and is not currently considering contracts.

6.13. Important Changes to Procurement Plan

EUSA does not currently have RPS compliance obligations and is not currently considering contracts. EUSA’s 2015 Procurement Plan is the same as its 2014 Procurement Plan.

6.15. Safety Considerations

EUSA does not currently have RPS compliance obligations and is not currently considering contracts.
