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FOURTH AMENDMENT

TO THE

LONG-TERM ENERGY AND CAPACITY

POWER PURCHASE AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

U. S. WINDPOWER, INC.

AND

PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY

This is the Fourth Amendment to the Long-Term Energy and Capacity Power Purchase Agreement signed by Pacific Gas and Electric Company ("PG&E"), a California corporation, on March 2, 1984, and by U. S. Windpower, Inc. ("USW"), a Delaware corporation, on March 5, 1984, relating to a 70,000 kW facility and identifying a scheduled operation date of April 1, 1987 (the "Agreement").

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Altamont Renegotiation Agreement dated May 27, 1988, USW and PG&E agreed that the undeveloped 1.6 MW portion of the Agreement (the "1.6 MW Portion") would be amended as provided herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exchange for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the 1.6 MW Portion is hereby amended as follows:

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1. The following paragraphs are added to the end of Section A-13 ASSIGNMENT:

"(c) 1.6 MW of this Agreement are undeveloped as of April 1, 1988. This 1.6 MW portion may only be developed as described in this paragraph (c). may, in accordance with this Section A-13, assign this undeveloped portion of this Agreement to an entity or entities for use in connection with wind turbines contributed by Seller to such entity or entities for purposes of fulfilling Seller's manufacturer's warranty obligations to such entity or entities for Windplants that were (i) installed by Seller, (ii) operating under this Agreement as of December 31, 1987, and (iii) operating under this Agreement as of the date of the proposed assignment ("Allowable Use"). Seller expressly agrees that it shall be reasonable for PG&E to withhold its consent to any assignment not made in connection with an Allowable Use.

(d) If on March 5, 1989, less than 1.6 MW of an Allowable Use are installed and operational under this 1.6 MW portion of the Agreement, the Agreement shall terminate to the extent of such undeveloped megawatts."
