RE: Extension of time for CPUC Approval under the January 1, 2009 Substitution Agreement between Sierra Pacific Industries (SPI) and Pacific Gas Electric & Company (PG&E)

Dear Mr. Branchcomb:

Sierra Pacific Industries, Inc. ("Seller") and Pacific Gas and Electric Company ("PG&E") (collectively "Parties") are parties to January 1, 2009 agreement that modified an Interim Standard Offer Four Power Purchase Agreement by substituting the non-operable 12.5 MW Susanville facility with an operable 7.5 MW biomass plant located in Sonora, California ("Agreement").

PG&E filed the Agreement for Approval in Advice Letter 3433-E on March 12, 2009 in accordance with the Restructuring Advice Letter Filing ("RALF") process designated in CPUC Decision 98-12-066. Shortly thereafter, on March 23, 2009, SPI announced plans to close the Sonora facility. As a result, the RALF process was no longer the applicable CPUC approval process and Advice Letter 3433-E ultimately had to be withdrawn. The Parties are currently seeking approval of the Agreement through an advice letter filing.

The Agreement states in Section 8.1 that, "[T]his Agreement will terminate on the earlier of (a) September 1, 2009; or (b) the last day of the month of the month in which PG&E gives notice to SPI that the CPUC has not granted CPUC approval as specified in Section 7."

Due to delays in CPUC approval resulting from the unanticipated closure of the Sonora mill, the Parties have agreed to amend Section 8.1 of the Agreement to state that: "[T]his Agreement will terminate on the earlier of (a) June 30, 2010; or (b) the last day of the month of the month in which PG&E gives notice to SPI that the CPUC has not granted CPUC approval as specified in Section 7."
