Subject: Letter Agreement Extending QF Contract Log No. 04H061QPA (Indian Valley Hydro Project)

This letter agreement ("Extension Agreement") sets forth the terms and conditions under which the Qualifying Facility Contract identified by Log No. 04H061QPA (the "QF Contract") between Pacific Gas and Electric Company ("PG&E") and Yolo County Flood Control and Water Conservation District ("Seller") (collectively, the "Parties") and effective May 1, 2012 will be extended for four months ("Extension Period"), until August 31, 2013. Any capitalized term not defined in this Letter Agreement shall have the meaning provided in the QF Contract.

- 1. Term:** Section 1.01 "Term" subsection (b) shall be deleted and replaced with the following: "The Term ends sixteen months after the Term Start Date (the "Term End Date");
- 2. CAISO Tariff Compliance:** CAISO has temporarily exempted Seller from the requirement to install CAISO-Approved Meters using specific communication methods until September 4, 2013. Pursuant to Section 3.09(b), Seller has provided Buyer with a copy of CAISO's exemption letter dated September 4, 2012. The CAISO's letter is attached and made a part of this Letter Agreement.
- 3. No Other Changes:** All other provisions of the QF Contract shall remain in effect.

Subject: Temporary Communication Exemption using Alternative Communication Methods - Modem
Site: Indian Valley Hydro Project

Ms. Barton,

In accordance with Section 10.2.12 of the ISO Tariff and the ISO Business Practice Manual for Metering Section 8, the ISO has authority to exempt ISO Metered Entities from various metering requirements referred to in the Tariff. This letter represents the ISO's response to your request to use a modem device associated with a Telco phone number in lieu of the Energy Communication Network (ECN) ISO meter communications standard. Listed below are the conditions associated with this Temporary Exemption.

- Meets resource characteristics
- Exemptions are limited to a maximum term of one year with the possibility of automatic renewal (one year) based on data collection and performance history.
- Alternative communication equipment and/or devices must be associated with the Generator/Resource Owners network, with the exception of the wireless carrier if applicable.
