BE IT RESOLVED by the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California that gas and electric utilities operating in California under the jurisdiction of the Commission may destroy the records at the expiration of the retention periods prescribed in the Federal Power Commission's revised Regulations to Govern the Preservation of Records of Public Utilities Licensees, effective January 1, 1956, provided, however, that where rates are subject to refund customers' accounting records must be retained until further order of the Commission.
